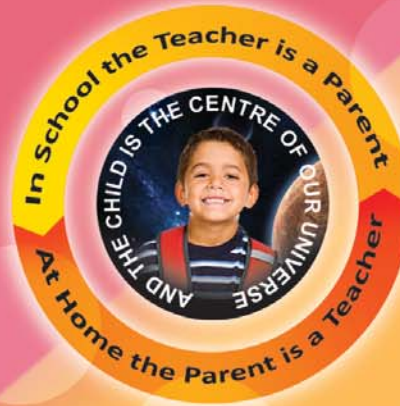

ADMISSION PROCEDURE & PAYMENT OF FEE

At the time of registration, the following documents along with registration fee should be submitted in the Front office. Filled in form should be submitted in the office along with

- (1) Latest coloured passport size photograph of the student.
- (2) Photograph of the parent with the child in [5cm x 3.5cm]
- (3) Photocopy of Birth Certificate (attested).
- (4) Photocopy of the result of the previous class (attested).
- (5) In case the registration form is filled by guardians other than parents, it should be clearly indicated

* A basic admission test will be conducted on specified date for eligibility of that particular class. Only those candidates who clear the test will be called for an interview, both parents are required to be present at the time of the interview.

Age Criteria (As on 31st March of the admission year)

LKG - Should have completed 3 years 6 months

UKG - Should have completed 4 years 6 months

Std. I - Should have completed 5 years 6 months and so on
Note : Incomplete or illegible Registration forms, without photos will not be accepted.

* The admission would be confirmed only after the final interview.

* Admission is strictly subject to fulfilling of all conditions and submission of requisite documents.

TC from the previous school must be submitted at the time of admission. Outstation children must get their TC countersigned by DEO (District Educational Officer)

FEE PAYMENT

Fee is subject to change from time to time. Total Fee for the whole year is to be paid in three instalments.

1st instalment – Between 1st April to 15th April

2nd instalment - Between 1st August to 15th August

3rd instalment - Between 1st December to 15th December
